35% of FACES students are first generation high school graduates


The average household income of 2022 FACES students was \$49,000 for an average household of 4.5.

FACES students speak a total of 26 languages across all programs.




#### INTERNSHIP EXPERIENCE

Of the students who participated in an internship, this many agreed that...










# COVID-19 Vaccination
