

## **FACES Public Health Youth Corps** Peer COVID-19 Educator Program

In 2017, FACES for the Future implemented our first ever Public Health Youth Corps. Now, we're leveraging our experience and 22 years of success working with diverse high school students to meet the needs of communities most impacted by COVID-19.

## In the 2021-22 Academic Year, 310 FACES PHYC Students:

Spoke 26 different languages	Served 86 Zip Codes in CA, NM, MI, and CO
Held 117 Peer-to- Peer Outreach Events	Conducted 676 community presentations on COVID-19
Created 261 youth-friendly videos, flyers, and social media posts on COVID-19	Utilized innovative approaches - like t-shirts with QR codes to CDC info
